The One Book New Jersey Committee offers a terrific opportunity for your library to be recognized for your programming efforts. Libraries are encouraged to submit their One Book New Jersey programs to the committee. Programs may be focused on any of the 2009 books. Programs may be submitted by any public or school library. Prizes will be awarded based on the following criteria.

1. Originality – Did you come up with a unique idea to promote the reading of a One Book New Jersey title? The Committee is looking for programs that are out of the ordinary for kids, teens or adults.
2. Publicity – Be sure to tell us how you publicized your program, especially if you went beyond the flyer/press release route.
3. Community Outreach – Did you involve any group or organization outside your library or school? This could be anything from a school/public library model to working with another town to partnering with any other local club or agency.
4. Replication – We are looking for programs that could be replicated by other communities to promote One Book New Jersey books.

To submit your program for consideration, you must fill out the Contest form and include copies of your publicity. The committee would also love to see any other documentation, including pictures of your event.

Prizes will be awarded only to the Library that submits the information. If you collaborated with another library, only one library may submit that program.

Programs must be submitted by October 31, 2009.
Contest winners will be announced in December 2009.
